16 gauge steel enclosure can be flush or surface mounted. All electronics installed on simple screw and post hinge door, allowing for efficient installation. Highly visible 3" red button with white "PUSH FOR HELP". Bright white LED clearly identifies when the Remote is being acknowledged by Master Command Panel. Amber LED and audible tone signal when the Remote has been activated. All Remotes are addressable and supervised with trouble indicated at Master Command Panel. Integrated 2 watt mylar cone speaker with vandal resistant grille. High barrier terminal strip mounted in back box for site wiring. Knockouts on top and bottom of enclosure.
