
DESCRIPTION:

The ES-4P is an air-actuated on/off switch with outlets 1, 2 and 3 switched together. Outlet 4 is continuous.

CAUTION:

USE COPPER CONDUCTORS ONLY. Do not lubricate relays. All Allied Innovations, LLC controls must be installed by a licensed electrician according to these instructions.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS READ AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. CAUTION: Risk of Electric shock. Install the electrical control box at least 5 feet (1.52 m) from inside wall of the pool, spa or hot tub.
- 2. Use only non-conductive tubing to any air actuator.
- 3. The electrical supply for this product must include a suitable rated switch or circuit breaker to open all ungrounded supply conductors to comply with section 422-20 of the National electric code, ANSI/NFPA 70-1987.
- 4. WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury, do not permit children to use this product unless they are closely supervised at all times.
- 5. For units for use in other than single family dwellings, a clearly labeled emergency switch shall be provided as part of the installation. The Switch shall be readily accessible to occupants and shall be installed at least 5 feet (1.52m) away, adjacent to, and within sight of the unit.
- 6. A pressure wire connector is provided on metallic enclosures to permit connections of a minimum No. 8 AWG solid copper bonding conductor between any metal equipment, metal enclosures of electrical equipment, metal water pipe, or conduit within 5 feet (1.5 m) of the unit as needed to comply with local requirements. Plastic enclosures are supplied with an internal equipment ground bar.
- 7. THIS CONTROL MUST BE FACTORY INSTALLED BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN ACCORDING TO STATE, NATIONAL, AND LOCAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND INSTRUCTIONS.
- 8. Use copper conductors only.
- 9. Install conduit down to provide drainage of compartment for electrical components.
- 10. A ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) designated line is to be installed in accordance with National Electrical Code, Canadian Electrical Code and all local codes in effect at the time of installation. When unit is provided with GFCI, the GFCI must be tested monthly. To conduct the test, the unit must be operating. Push the test button. The unit should stop operating and the reset button should appear. Push the reset button. The unit should now operate normally. If the interrupter fails to operate in this manner, there is a ground flowing. Indicating the possibility of electrical shock. Disconnect the power unit. The fault has been corrected.

WARRANTY
