
Assembly Instructions

- Carefully layout all parts in a line on a smooth surface, and use the following steps to assemble the lamp.
- Install an E12, Type B, 15 watt bulb (not included) or E12, LED, 1 watt bulb (not included) Note: For bulb replacement, remove shade and replace the bulb.
- 3. Install shade (C) into base (A)
- 4. Plug into the wall outlet for use.
- 5. Use the in-line switch (B) to turn the item ON and OFF



Note: The pedals on the lamp holder may need to be finessed to ensure the shade fits securely.

CAUTION - Refer to the wattage caution label located near the lampholder for recommended maximum wattage-do not exceed recommended wattage.

WARNING - Do not attempt to replace the bulb while the lamp is plugged into a wall receptacle.

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Make sure that your lamp is not plugged into the electrical outlet.
- 2. Squeeze the two spring clips "C" and insert them into the glass shade "D".
- 3. Insert the light bulb "A" into the socket "B".


 CAUTION Refer to the wattage caution label located near the lamp holder for recommended maximum wattage-do not exceed recommended wattage.

- 4. Plug the electrical cord into an outlet and turn on the lamp with the line switch.



- 8. Next carefully install the shade into base.
 - **NOTE**: Please be careful when installing the shade into the base, the shade is fragile.
- 9. Plug into the wall outlet for use.
- 10. Use the in-line switch to turn the item ON and OFF
